Reports should be made to the Board prior to public comment or questions. Upon completion of the report, the Board shall entertain questions/comments from members of the public when recognized by the Board's presiding officer.

Notice: Items on the agenda may be taken out of order; the Genoa Town Board may combine two or more agenda items for consideration, and the Genoa Town Board may remove an item from the agenda or delay discussion relating to an item on the agenda at any time.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

This portion of the meeting is open to the public to speak on any topic not on today's agenda and must be limited to 3 minutes. For any item on the agenda, public comment may be permitted at the discretion of the Board's presiding officer, except where public hearing is legally required. The Genoa Town Advisory Board is prohibited by Law from taking immediate action on or discussing issues raised by the public that are not listed on this agenda.

ADMINISTRATIVE AGENDA

1. For possible action: Discussion and possible action regarding the selection of a Genoa Town Manager. This will include having each of the top three candidates, Shirley Leschinsky, Philip Ritger

and Molly Walt, appear before the Town Board to answer questions and present why they should be chosen as the next Town Manager. Each candidate's entire interview may not exceed 45 minutes. After the presentations, the Board will take public comment, followed by a discussion and vote of the Town Board to rank the candidates, authorize Douglas County Human Resources to conduct a background investigation, and authorize the Chair to negotiate salary and hire a successful candidate. (3 hours).

2. For possible action. Discussion to approve the Town of Genoa's sponsorship of the 2014 Cowboy Festival to be held May 2-4, 2014, with public comment prior to Board Action. (5 Minutes)
