Join us for some ghoulish games, freaky fun and cool prizes for everyone in costume.

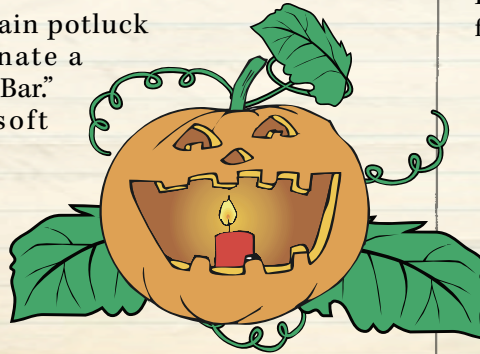
Parents: Please bring a main potluck dish for the dinner, or donate a bottle of wine for the "Parents Bar."
