Applications should be submitted with a \$15 non-refundable fee no later than Saturday, March 16, 2010. Booth space fees range from \$365 to \$500 for a 10' x 10' space. Food booth fees are \$700 for a 12' x 12' space.

Activity booth applications are available through the Town offices only. Fees for a 10' x 10' area begin at \$165. Activities can include everything from face painting, moon bounces, children's rides and interactive arts booths for youth and their families.

This year's Candy Dance will be held Saturday and Sunday, September 25-26. Last year over 300 artists, crafters and food vendors participated in the Faire.
