temporary road closures in Genoa for purpose of ensuring public safety during the 5th Annual Genoa Cowboy Festival: Main Street/Jack's Valley Road between Nixon and 5th Street in the Town of Genoa will be closed for a period of four (4) days for the 5th Annual Genoa Cowboy Festival. The closure will start at 8 a.m. Thursday, May 1 and through 5 p.m. on Sunday, May 4, 2014. This section of Main Street will be closed to all through traffic. North bound through traffic on Foothill Road must use Carson Street to Genoa Street to 5th Street to get to Jack's Valley Road, or Foothill Road to Genoa Lane to get to Highway 395. South bound through traffic on Jack's Valley Road must use 5th Street to Genoa Street to Carson Street to get to Foothill Road.

Temporary speed bumps and radar speed enforcement will be in place on Kinsey Way during the Cowboy Festival weekend to remind residents and guests alike that this is a 15 mph residential speed zone with children present. Please remember to slow down when using Kinsey Way.

Nixon Street and Mill Street will be closed from Main to Genoa Street beginning on Friday, May 2 and Saturday, May 3 from 7 a.m. until 10 p.m. and Sunday, May 4 from 9 a.m. until 3 p.m. Residents and businesses located on these roads will only have access during these times.

We appreciate your patience with these temporary road closures during the Cowboy Festival and appreciate your support towards ensuring safety for our residents and visitors during this time.

BEARS!

Bears become increasingly active with an early spring and warmer weather. As a resident living in bear habitat (all of Genoa) you are responsible for proper storage of trash and pet / horse / animal feed. In the late summer and fall, you are also encouraged to remove ripened fruit from your trees before bears become conditioned to eating it in your yard. As a reminder, Douglas County Ordinance 6.32 is in effect and will be enforced, "...a responsible party must not allow a bear to gain access to garbage..." There is zero tolerance for violations.
